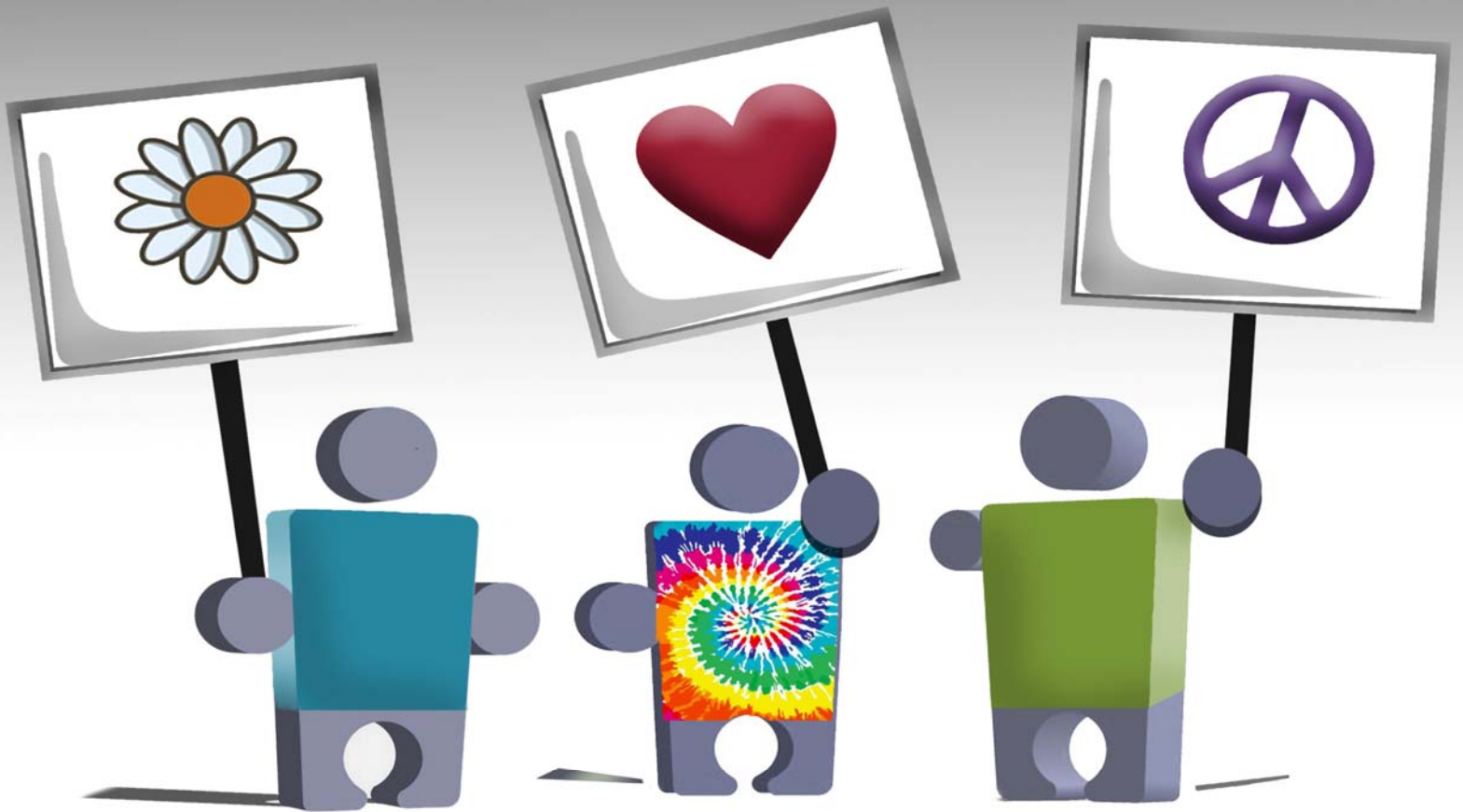

Vision and Goals

The conference is a step in implementing the vision outlined in the *Individuals with Autism and Their Families, Oklahoma Plan*. The vision within the Oklahoma Plan is that Oklahoma has a system of support for people with ASD and their families, and all professionals working with people with ASD understand the disorder, provide contemporary and effective services and receive ongoing professional development that is based on the most up-to-date evidence-based information. Our goals for the conference are:

1. To provide evidence-based information on ASD for use by pre-service personnel preparation programs, families and advocates, and community programs, healthcare professionals and childcare, early intervention and school personnel;
2. To promote statewide and local capacity building activities;
3. To increase awareness and knowledge of needs, interests, and solutions that result in meaningful change and community participation for individuals with ASD and their families; and
4. To promote collaboration between the autism organizations in Oklahoma.

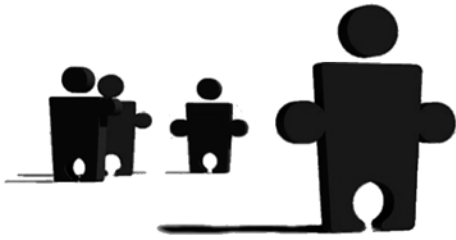

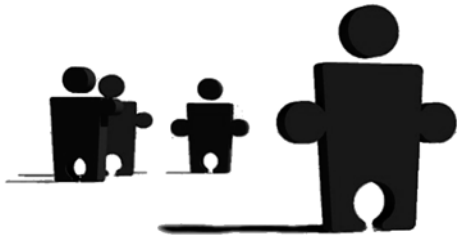
